

## YELLOW RIBBON FUND (YRF) STAR BURSARY [ACADEMIC TRACK]

#### APPLICATION PACKAGE

#### **About the Bursary**

The Yellow Ribbon Fund (YRF) STAR (Skills Training Assistance to Restart) Bursary was conceptualised in 2010 to provide financial assistance to low-income ex-offenders who wish to upgrade and upskill themselves after their release.

It aims to support ex-offenders to build viable futures for themselves and their families through upgrading, which will enhance employability and encourage self-sufficiency. The beneficiaries of the YRF STAR Bursary will also serve as role models for other ex-offenders and inspire them to rebuild their lives through education.

#### **Bursary Details**

- a. The bursary is available for local institutions and selected private institutions for the following courses:
  - GCE N, O, A Levels
  - Nitec/Higher Nitec
  - Diploma
  - Degree
  - Graduate Diploma
- b. The bursary funds up to 100% of course fees for ex-offenders who have been released for not more than five years. For those who have been released more than five years, the bursary will fund up to 50%.
- c. The bursary is also open for application to inmates who are due for release soon and wish to pursue higher education after release.
- d. Applicants may have to undergo career coaching as part of the assessment process.
- e. YRF reserves the right to revoke any bursary awarded if the progress, performance and behaviour of the student are deemed to be unsatisfactory.
- f. Students are to engage in one case session per month with the assigned case manager.
- g. Students are to attend all Get Together sessions and help out in all Yellow Ribbon related events as a volunteer, when required.



#### **Eligibility Criteria**

Applicants must fulfil the following eligibility criteria and conditions:

- Must be a Singaporean or Permanent Resident;
- Household per capita income not exceeding \$1,500. For applicants with household per capita income of more than \$1,500, they will be assessed on a case-by-case basis; and
- Must not have been released from prison for more than 5 years. Applicants who have been released for more than 5 years will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

#### **Instructions for Submission of Application**

- 1. Complete all sections of the application form.
- 2. Attach the certified true copies of all relevant supporting documents listed on Page 6 of the application form.
- 3. All applications are subject to the evaluation and approval of YRF. Applicants will be required to undergo an interview meant to assess their suitability. The award of the bursary is at the sole discretion of YRF and YRF is not obliged to reveal the reasons for rejection.
- 4. Incomplete applications and/or cases where there is a lack of documentary proof will not be accepted.
- 5. All applicants should email the completed application form together with the necessary supporting documents to the Yellow Ribbon Fund Secretariat at Angela\_SWEE@yellowribbon.gov.sg.
